He is also a Fellow of the American College of Foot and Ankle Orthopedics and Medicine and a Fellow of the American Academy of Podiatric Sports Medicine.

Currently, Dr. Richie has faculty appointments at the California School of Podiatric Medicine (Oakland, Ca) as well as the Podiatric Medical School at Western University (Pomona, Ca). He is the Chairman of the Podiatric Medical Education Committee at the California School of Podiatric Medicine.

He has been an invited speaker at over 100 medical symposiums throughout the United States as well as the United Kingdom, Canada, Spain and Australia.

Recent Insights in Adult Acquired Flatfoot

Dr Richie is world renowned for his expertise on the adult acquired flatfoot (AAF)/posterior tibial tendon dysfunction (PTTD). 20 years of biomechanical research has enabled new insights into this enigmatic condition. Dr Richie's presentation will focus on an updated classification system and assessment as well as most recent insights regarding treatments. Recent studies have demonstrated that conservative treatment with AFO bracing and functional rehabilitation has replaced surgery as the best intervention for Stage 2 deformity and this will be discussed.
